

[International] Abstract Guideline

Important Dates

- Abstract Submission Close: SEP. 28, 2026
- Notification of Abstract Acceptance: After Oct 5, 2026

How to Write Abstracts

- Accepted abstracts will be allocated to oral or E-Poster based on the submitters' choices.
- The content of the abstract is solely the responsibility of the author, and any published articles will not be accepted.
- All abstracts must be written in English.

General requirements

- Structural abstract of < 500 words, to include the following sections: Objectives, Methods, Results, Conclusions
- The word limit does not include the title, tables and figures.
- Maximum number of figures and tables: 2

How to Submit Abstracts

- All abstracts must be submitted through the website.
- * Abstract(s) sent by mail or fax will not be processed by the Secretariat and will not be forwarded to the Scientific Committee for review.
- All abstracts submitted will be automatically edited according to the submission format. It is authors' responsibility to review the submissions and correct things. Submitters are responsible for every typing error on the abstract.
- Please do not submit multiple copies of the same abstract.
- Presenting authors are encouraged to submit the abstract.

Abstracts Process

- Once abstract submission has been completed, a confirmation letter will be automatically delivered to registrants. If there is no confirmation letter after abstract submission, please contact the Secretariat.
- Abstracts will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee. Notification of acceptance will be sent to presenting authors via e-mail after Oct 5, 2026.
- International Abstract Presenters of Oral and Moderated Poster Session will be provided travel grant (500 USD) after the onsite presentation.
- All of the International Abstract Presenters, including the E-poster presenters, are eligible for the registration fee waiver.

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How to Write Cases

- All Case must be written in English
- Do not include patient's full name (initial or identifier number allowed)
- For brand drugs, include generic names in parentheses
- When cases are submitted, we assume that the authors grant copyright to the Conference Organization for publication on the website.
- International Abstract Presenters of Oral and Moderated Poster Session will be provided travel grant (500 USD) after the onsite presentation.
- All of the International Abstract Presenters, including the E-poster presenters, are eligible for the registration fee waiver.
